

Proceedings of the Commissioners

The Sheridan County Board of Commissioners met in person on July 6, 2021, at the County Courthouse. Notice of the meeting was published on the county website sheridancountyne.gov. The meeting was open to the public and a ZOOM connection was also available. Present were Chairman Loren Paul, Commissioners Bruce Messersmith and James Krotz, Clerk Cindy Coburn, Assessor Tina Skinner and Treasurer Renee Thies.

Road Superintendent Richard Cross reported some damage to roads in an area north of Mirage Flats over the weekend by heavy rain.

The BOC voted to declare a shelving unit in the Veterans Service Office “surplus” and offer it for sale.

The BOC approved an application for a Special Designated License for the Fuel Grill LLC to serve alcohol for a Barn Dance and Wedding at the Barns at Galyen farms on July 31.

Acting as the Board of Equalization (BOE) the Commissioners approved two correction sheets accelerating the personal property taxes for Larry Galyen and for Galyen Farms. The BOE reviewed and approved a list of one overvalued and four undervalued properties presented by Assessor Tina Skinner.

The Board of Equalization reviewed Valuation Protests on 20 properties.

The next meeting of the BOE and BOC is scheduled for Tuesday, July 13, at 9:00 in the Commissioners’ Chambers in the Courthouse and will be open to the public. The meeting will also be available on ZOOM – check the Public Notices page of the county website for meeting number and passcode.
