The Sheridan County Board of Commissioners (BOC) met on Tuesday, December 26, 2023, at the County Courthouse. Notice of the meeting was published on the county website sheridancountyne.gov. The meeting was open to the public and a ZOOM connection was also available. Present were Vice Chairman James Krotz and Commissioner Dan Kling, Deputy Clerk Paige Rager, Clerk of the District Court Carol Stouffer, and Treasurer Renee Thies. There was no business for the Board of Equalization (BOE).

The BOC approved the revised bylaws of the County Extension Board and approved the election of Morgan Weyers and Trevor Ginkens to the Extension Board.

Interim Road Superintendent Rod Norton reported that the Department had received several job applications recently.

The BOC and Norton met briefly in Executive session. No action was taken.

Treasurer Renee Thies presented her report on pledged securities which was then approved.

Thies presented a proposed Resolution directing her to close the Ed Hollstein Education Fund and transfer the funds to the Hollstein Scholarship Fund at GRHS. The Board approved the resolution.

The Commissioners contacted Roger Ray by telephone to discuss the need for prairie dog control on his property.
