

Proceedings of the Commissioners

The Sheridan County, Nebraska Board of Equalization (BOE) and Board of Commissioners (BOC) met on Tuesday, July 23, 2024, at the County Courthouse in Rushville. Notice of the meeting was published on the county website sheridancounty.ne.gov. The meeting was open to the public and a ZOOM connection was also available. Present were Chairman James Krotz, Commissioners Dan Kling and Bruce Messersmith, County Clerk Sindy Coburn, and Treasurer Renee Thies.

There was no business for the Board of Equalization.

The Commissioners Audited and approved claims for payment.

The BOC reviewed and approved an Engagement Letter presented by Casey Peterson CPAs for Audit services for the coming year. The projected cost of the Audit is \$22,500.

Interim Road Superintendent Rod Norton reported that every available motor-grader was in operation last Thursday after some much needed rain. Five blades were on the roads on Friday (overtime) until the moisture evaporated.

The Board approved and Norton and the Chairman signed the Annual Certification of Compliance statement for submission to the State.

Luke Bonkiewicz of the Nebraska Association of County Officials reported on property tax legislation being consider by the special session of the Unicameral and briefed the Commissioners on development of the NACO salary study website.

Dustin Will of Benefits Management presented his Health Insurance renewal proposal for the coming year. The BOC voted to renew the county plan with MEDICA with a premium increase of 8.3%.

The next meeting of the BOE/BOC is scheduled for Tuesday, August 20 at 9:00 a.m.
