The Sheridan County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:15 A.M. in the Commissioners Office, Courthouse. Paul and Krotz present, Messersmith excused. Paul stated that the meeting would be conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Nebraska Open Meeting Act. Krotz made a motion to accept the agenda. Paul seconded the motion. All voted aye. Road Superintendent Tom Kuester informed the board that Shell Lake Road has been reopened after two days of pumping water. Also discussion was had about roads in the southern end of the county.

Bryan Venable of Panhandle Area Development District (PADD) met with the board request their membership for the coming fiscal year. Venable made the board aware of training initiatives and community development grants.

Julie Haugen of the Silver Dollar Bar in Hay Springs requested the boards approval for a Special Designated License that would allow her to serve at a wedding reception to be held at the Barns at Galyen Farms.
