

COMMISSIONERS MINUTES

JUNE 17, 2019

The Sheridan County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:15 A.M. in the Commissioners Office, Courthouse. All members present. Paul stated that the meeting would be conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Nebraska Open Meeting Act. Krotz made a motion to accept the agenda. Messersmith seconded the motion. All voted aye. Messersmith made a motion to approve the minutes of 6-10-2019. Krotz seconded the motion. All voted aye.

The board signed claim checks and audited and approve salary claims in the amount of General-\$ 203,231.93 ; Road-\$112,380.02 ; Weed-\$5,236.45 Total \$320,848.40.

Road Superintendent Tom Kuester informed the board that NIRMA (the County's insurance company) will be accepting bids on the D-7 dozer that was damaged due to flooding. Those interested in submitting a bid should contact the Road Department.

Kuester visited with the board about the purchase of gravel and fixing equipment.

Deputy Sheriff Everett Langford presented a quote from Action Communications for 7 Bluetooth microphones for \$3,500 along with a request that the expense be covered by the Wired E-911 funds. The microphones will enable the officers to connect directly with their patrol car radios when outside the unit. Krotz made a motion to authorize the expense of \$3,500 for microphones for the Sheriff patrol cars to be paid with Wired E-911 funds. Messersmith seconded the motion. With a roll call vote all voted aye.

Building Superintendent Jeff Davis reported that Fuller construction has informed him that reconstruction of the south ramp and steps will begin mid-summer.

Extension Educator Jack Arterburn reported that his office has received and is helping distribute a generous donation of fencing supplies to ranchers/farmers hit by recent storms.

Assessor Tina Skinner met with the board to continue discussion of computer upgrades. Jeremy Harris from MANNA Systems visited with the board by telephone about his proposal. No action was taken.

The board reviewed a proposal for budget preparation for 2019-2020. Messersmith made a motion to accept the proposal of Erin Heath, CPA of Cody NE for budget preparation services for 2019-2020. Krotz seconded the motion. With a roll call vote all voted aye.
