

COMMISSIONERS MINUTES

JULY 15, 2019

The Sheridan County Board of Commissioners met in regular session at 9 A.M. in the Commissioners Office, Courthouse. All members present. Paul stated that the meeting would be conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Nebraska Open Meeting Act. Messersmith made a motion to accept the agenda. Krotz seconded the motion. All voted aye. Krotz made a motion to approve the minutes of 7-8-2019. Messersmith seconded the motion. All voted aye.

The board audited and approved claims in the amount of General-\$54,884.59; Road-\$272,662.75; Highway Bridge Buy Back-\$85,000; Visitors Promotion-\$3.87; Visitors Improvement-\$2,000; Inheritance-\$85,000; Wireless 911-\$802.39; Insurance-\$4,405.40; Weed-\$582.68; E-911-\$656.50 Total \$505,998.18.

Clerk of District Court Carol Stouffer met with the board to discuss security concerns in the courtroom and Courthouse.

Road Superintendent Tom Kuester informed the board that the purchase of the site of the Lakeside shop from the Board of Educational Lands & Funds has been completed. Kuester also stated that the first meeting with the FEMA representatives went well. The representatives plan to come every Thursday.

The board reviewed a letter from Gordon Golf and Country Club requesting a 8 A.M. opening of the bar for a tournament on August 4, 2019. Krotz made a motion to approve the request for the Gordon Golf and Country Club. Messersmith seconded the motion. With a roll call vote all voted aye.

Sheriff Brewer met with the board to visit about activities going on in his department and to discuss some safety issues.

Maintenance Supervisor Jeff Davis visited with the board about new doors for the District Court Room and other safety issues. Davis showed the board pictures of the Courthouse roof. The board agreed to go ahead and get estimates. The counties insurance company (NIRMA) has been notified.
