The Sheridan County Board of Commissioners met by zoom at 9:05 A.M. On January 19, 2021. Zoom ID#3358213334 Passcode 568237. All members present along with Geri Landreth, Deputy County Clerk, Renee Thies, County Treasurer and Richard Cross Road Superintendent. Paul stated that the meeting would be conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Nebraska Open Meeting Act.
