

COMMISSIONERS MINUTES

JULY 27, 2021

The Sheridan County Commissioners met in regular session and by zoom at 9 A.M. on July 27, 2021. Zoom ID#3358213334 Passcode 65274. All members present. Paul stated that the meeting would be conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Nebraska Open Meeting Act. This meeting was posted on the official website and published in the Sheridan County Journal Star on July 21, 2021. Messersmith made a motion to accept the agenda. Krotz seconded the motion. All voted aye. Messersmith made a motion to approve the minutes of 7-20-2021. Krotz seconded the motion. All voted aye.

Chairman Paul signed a disaster declaration for damage done by the July 9, 2021 storm in the southern end of the county. Panhandle Rural Electric Membership Association (PREMA) lost 20 utility poles worth \$48,000. The disaster declaration is necessary in the process of securing state and federal funds for repairs.

Road Superintendent Richard Cross reported on an overlay for a road within Road District #33. The board asked Cross to get a letter from the Road District showing approval for this project.

Cross informed the board that they are planning to start to reclaim the Weldon/Tallon pit next week.

Joe Headrick presented the board his plan for the inclusion of student representatives on public boards and councils.

The board was scheduled to do a jail inspection but due to the County Fair and the short staffing in the Sheriff's Office the board will reschedule it until mid August.
