The Sheridan County Commissioners met in regular session and by zoom at 9:15 A.M. on September 28, 2021. Zoom ID#3358213334 Passcode 625274. Krotz and Messersmith present and Paul present by zoom. Paul stated that the meeting would be conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Nebraska Open Meeting Act. This meeting was posted on the official website and published in the Sheridan County Journal Star on September 22, 2021. Messersmith made a motion to accept the agenda. Krotz seconded the motion. All voted aye. Krotz made a motion to approve the minutes of 9-21-2021. Messersmith seconded the motion. All voted aye.

County Treasurer Renee Thies was present by zoom. The board reviewed the tax sale certificates presented. Messersmith made a motion to adopt Resolution 2021-20 directing the county Treasurer to issue tax sale certificates to the County of Sheridan upon all parcels of real estate upon which there are delinquent taxes. Krotz seconded the motion. With a roll call vote all voted aye.

The board also reviewed the 2020 Distress Warrant Report presented by the Treasurer.

Road Superintendent Richard Cross reported that the armor coat project is done in the Mirage Flats area. Cross stated that his department will be going back to 8 hour work days October 18, 2021.

The board reviewed a building agreement with Senior Services, Inc. for office space. Krotz made a motion to approve the Building Agreement with Senior Services, Inc at the rate of \$1,600 in kind donation/month for provided facility space. Messersmith seconded the motion. With a roll call vote all voted aye.

Deputy Sheriff Everette Langford requested the board review an interlocal agreement for E911 equipment. Krotz made a motion to approve an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement with North Central 911 Region Communication Equipment Sharing for Boyd Holt #911 and Antelope, Sheridan, Cherry, Brown and Rock Counties. Messersmith seconded the motion. With a roll call vote all voted aye.
