## **COMMISSIONERS MINUTES**

## APRIL 19, 2022

The Sheridan County Commissioners met in regular session and by zoom at 9:15 A.M. on April 19, 2022. Meeting ID #9376535799 passcode 625274. Krotz and Messersmith were present. Kling was excused.

Messersmith stated that the meeting would be conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Nebraska Open Meeting Act. This meeting was posted on the official website and published in the Sheridan County Journal Star on April 13, 2022. Krotz made a motion to accept the agenda. Messersmith seconded the motion. With a roll call vote all voted aye. Krotz made a motion to approve the minutes of 4-12-2022. Messersmith seconded the motion. On a roll call vote all voted aye.

The board audited and approved salary claims and signed claim checks.

Building & Grounds had no report.

Road Superintendent Richard Cross visited with the board about further explanation of the gravel bids. Cross also visited with the board about some construction projects.

Weed Superintendent Seth Tausan and members of the Prairie Dog Control Board Jean Parker, Jerry Meyring and Lloyd Kearns met with the board for an update. There are currently no forced control projects underway.

Krotz made a motion to re-appoint Jean Parker for a 3 year term to the Prairie Dog Advisory Board. Messersmith seconded the motion. With a roll call vote all voted aye.

Assessor Tina Skinner visited with the board on the "Reports and Opinions" from the State Property Tax Administrator.

Skinner also presented a letter to the board requesting that the County pay 75% of employee/spouse and employee/child health insurance and 75% of the family health insurance. The board said they would consider it at budget time but did not feel that it would be possible.

No discussion was had on ARPA funds.
