COMMISSIONERS MINUTES

JUNE 21, 2022

The Sheridan County Commissioners met in regular session and by Zoom (ID# 93997918251 Passcode 625274) at 9:20 A.M. Kling and Krotz present. Messersmith was excused due to illness.

Vice Chairman Krotz stated that the meeting would be conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Nebraska Open Meeting Act. This meeting was posted on the official County website and published in the Sheridan County Journal Star on June 15, 2022. Kling made a motion to accept the agenda. Krotz seconded the motion. With a roll call vote all voted aye. Kling made a motion to approve the minutes of 6-14-2022. Krotz seconded the motion. With a roll call vote all voted aye.

The Board audited and approved salary claims and signed claim checks.

Cross requested that the 1994 CAT G Motor Grader be declared surplus so he can sell it on Big Iron. Kling made a motion to surplus the 1994 CAT G Motor Grader. Krotz seconded the motion. With a roll call vote all voted aye.

Scott Berndt was on the agenda but was not present.

Building & Grounds Superintendent Jeff Davis was present to inform the Board that the new back-up generator has been installed.

Deputy County Attorney Jamian Simmons presented a draft resolution that would establish a process for agencies and organizations to apply for ARPA funds to be distributed by the County. The board decided to wait until a full board was in attendance.

Simmons also reviewed with the board the statutes regarding both opencarry and concealed-carry firearms in county buildings. The board decided to wait until a full board was in attendance. Assessor Tina Skinner and Clerk Sindy Coburn presented additional information on LB-644 concerning public notice of proposed tax increase. Krotz made a motion to proceed with the purchase of the post cards from the Nebraska Department of Administrative Services Print Shop. Kling seconded the motion. With a roll call vote all voted aye.
