

## COMMISSIONERS MINUTES

AUGUST 8, 2023

The Sheridan County Commissioners met in regular session and by Zoom (ID# 93997918251 Passcode# 625274) at 9:15 A.M. on August 8, 2023. All members present along with Clerk Sindy Coburn, Assessor Tina Skinner, Treasurer Renee Thies and Highway Superintendent Richard Cross.

Messersmith stated that the meeting would be conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Nebraska Open Meeting Act. This meeting was posted on the official County website and posted in the Sheridan County Journal Star on August 2, 2023.

Krotz made a motion to accept the agenda. Kling seconded the motion. With a roll call vote all voted aye. Krotz made a motion to approve the minutes of 7-25-2023. Kling seconded the motion. With a roll call vote all voted aye.

The board audited and approved a claim to the US Treasurer for additional taxes. This claim needs paid in a timely manner due to interest being accessed.

The board reviewed the annual Highway Superintendent Certification from the State. Kling made a motion to adopt Resolution #2023-18 certifying to the compliance of the Road program to the Nebraska Board of Public Roads Classifications and Standards. Krotz seconded the motion. With a roll call vote all voted aye.

Kling made a motion to approve an application from the Fuel Grill in Gordon for a special liquor license to serve beer at the Monster Truck event at the county fairgrounds on August 25 & 26 from 5 P.M. to Midnight. Krotz seconded the motion. With a roll call vote all voted aye. The permit will be submitted to the State Liquor Commission.

Road Superintendent Richard Cross reported that recent rains are causing havoc with the roads. Crews are working on the problem areas. Crews have also dug nine test holes on the Brownlow property to check the gravel material. Cross is doing a sieve test and results will be available next meeting.

Building Superintendent Jeff Davis-no report.

Sheriff Jeff Brewer-no report.

Phyllis Lindsey and David Russell of the Sheridan County Ag Society reported on the recent Fair and Rodeo. Over all they were very happy with everything. Ticket sales were down but with the weather, State Baseball and Chadron Ranch Rodeo all taking place at the same time they were pleased.

Dustin Will from Benefit Management met with the board to discuss health insurance options comparable to the plan already in place. The board will review and visit again next week.

The board interviewed two applicants for the position of County Road Superintendent.
