

COMMISSIONERS MINUTES

April 16, 2024

The Sheridan County Commissioners met in regular session and by Zoom (ID# 93997918251 Passcode# 625274) at 9:15 A.M. All members present along with Deputy Clerk Paige Rager, Assessor Tina Skinner, Treasurer Renee Thies, Clerk of District Court Carol Stouffer and Interim Road Superintendent Rod Norton.

Krotz stated that the meeting would be conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Nebraska Open Meeting Act. This meeting was posted on the official County website and posted in the Sheridan County Journal Star on April 10, 2024.

Kling made a motion to accept the agenda. Messersmith seconded the motion. With a roll call vote all voted aye. Messersmith made a motion to approve the minutes of 4-9-2024. Kling seconded the motion. With a roll call vote all voted aye.

The board audited and approved claims for April.

Jean Andersen from AFLAC was present to give a report on employee participation in AFLAC supplemental insurance policies.

Interim Road Superintendent Rod Norton was present to give an update on the road department. Norton informed the board that the road work on 270th Lane; south of Highway 20 has been completed. Norton presented the board with a project expense sheet for this road; expenses totaled \$250,094 for the 3-mile stretch.

Building and Grounds Superintendent Jeff Davis was present to give an update on ongoing projects. Davis informed the board that the water heater and water softener in the jail needs to be replaced and will cost around \$6,600.

Sheriff Jeff Brewer was present to give the board an update on transportation cost for prisoners.

The Commissioners interviewed an applicant for the Road Superintendent position. No action was taken.
