

COMMISSIONERS MINUTES

JULY 22, 2025

The Sheridan County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:50 A.M. on July 22, 2025. All members present along with Clerk Sindy Coburn and Interim Road Superintendent Rod Norton.

Krotz stated that the meeting would be conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Nebraska Open Meeting Act. This meeting was posted on the official County website and posted in the Sheridan County Journal Star on July 16, 2025.

Kling made a motion to accept the agenda. Messersmith seconded the motion. With a roll call vote all voted aye. Messersmith made a motion to approve the minutes of 7-15-2025. Kling seconded the motion. With a roll call vote all voted aye.

The board signed claim checks and audited and approved salary claims. Check #25070064 payable to Kory Orr in the amount of \$84.00 was held due to a claim against the individual.

Interim Road Superintendent Rod Norton and Jack Beguin were present to discuss the installation of a new double auto gate on 467th Trail. Landowners are responsible for the installation and maintenance of auto gates on the county right of way and the Road Department constructs and maintains the approaches.

Norton reported that the gravel project on 470th Lane will be completed this week. He also presented a proposed design for lettering to identify county vehicles.

Weed Superintendent Melissa Grover reported that Dell Technologies has given a government discount for the purchase of computers for the Annex Building. Each tower will be \$776 with an

additional fee of \$230 for the software. Total project to be around \$5,500. The board directed them to proceed with the purchase.

Melissa Grover visited with the board about purchasing tables and chairs for the new meeting room at the annex building. The board agreed to the purchase and authorized it to come out of Courthouse Building Fund.

The board visited about the lack of progress on the new telephone system that was to be installed by Eakes Office Solutions. The board will contact Eakes and have them come to the August 12th meeting.

Public Comment: The board received the Pledged Security Report provided by the Treasurer.
