

COMMISSIONERS MINUTES

AUGUST 26, 2025

The Sheridan County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:15 A.M. on August 26, 2025. All members present along with Clerk Sindy Coburn, Carol Stouffer, Renee Thies and Interim Road Superintendent Rod Norton.

Krotz stated that the meeting would be conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Nebraska Open Meeting Act. This meeting was posted on the official County website and posted in the Sheridan County Journal Star on August 20, 2025.

Kling made a motion to accept the agenda. Messersmith seconded the motion. With a roll call vote all voted aye. Kling made a motion to approve the minutes of 8-19-2025. Messersmith seconded the motion. With a roll call vote all voted aye.

The board reviewed the Region 23 Hazard Mitigation Plan. County representative to the Region 23 Emergency Management Board, James Krotz was available for any questions. Kling made a motion to approve Resolution #2025-18 adopting the most recent FEMA approved version of the Region 23 Emergency Management Agency Hazard Mitigation Plan. Messersmith seconded the motion. With a roll call vote all voted aye.

County Treasurer Renee Thies presented the board the Pledged Security Report.

Interim Road Superintendent Rod Norton, Treasurer Thies and Clerk Coburn visited with the board about the \$75,000 transfer from the Road Department to the Inheritance. Upon discovery it was determined that this money was never used by the Road Department so no transfer was needed. Check# 25080077 for \$75,000 from the Road Fund will be voided and will not be budgeted for in 2025-26.

Norton reported on several projects that are being completed. Norton informed the board that Kustom Rock Crushing has provided the agreed upon 5,000 yards of gravel required.

Sheriff Jeff Brewer had nothing to report.
