The Sheridan County Commissioners met in regular session and by Zoom (ID# 93997918251 Passcode# 625274) at 9:18 A.M. All members present along with Deputy Clerk Paige Rager, Treasurer Renee Thies and Highway Superintendent Richard Cross.

Messersmith stated that the meeting would be conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Nebraska Open Meeting Act. This meeting was posted on the official County website and posted in the Sheridan County Journal Star on November 8, 2023.

Kling made a motion to accept the agenda. Krotz seconded the motion. With a roll call vote all voted aye. Krotz made a motion to approve the minutes of 10-24-2023. Kling seconded the motion. With a roll call vote all voted aye.

The board reviewed a request from MJD Ranch LLC for an amendment of a conservation easement. Krotz made a motion to approve the amendment of conservation easement. Kling seconded the motion. With a roll call vote Krotz and Kling voted yes, Messersmith voted no.
